## From the Director

Slow speeds of learning are the greatest challenge in education. Even after five years of schooling about half the children cannot read, write or do mathematics at the grade level. We do not have five more years to build up the skills of the children currently in our classrooms, many of whom are greatly lagging behind in the foundational skills after the COVID school closures of nearly two years. Clearly, highly disruptive methods are now required immediately, so that no child remains without the foundational skills this year itself, or the results will be further devastating.

What if we shared new disruptive methods of teaching that are making it possible to reach grade-level FLN skills in 5 months or less for the vast majority of primary-aged children who attend regular school.

Accelerating Learning for All or ALfA is a groundbreaking new pedagogy that radically speeds up learning. Its short, visual modules are arranged step-wise from known to unknown and simple to complex. These help children scaffold learning by working in pairs to dramatically improve learning outcomes.

This transformative pedagogy empowers children with the 21st Century Skills of collaboration, communication, creativity, critical Thinking, character, and citizenship, as anticipated by NIPUN Bharat Mission and the New Education Policy of India.

ALfA is not an incremental change made to an existing system of education, but rather a paradigm shift, much like the new smartphone is to the old landline phone, that employs vastly different thinking and design. DEVI aims to be a catalyst in creating replicable models of change. It is collaborating with donors and NGOs to initiate changes in diverse fields like education, Income generation, skill development, entrepreneurship, health care, and awareness-building campaigns.

It has been another big year for us at DEVI Sansthan as we partner with governments and NGOs across India - including Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarkhand, Rajasthan, West Bengal and Mizoram - to scale up transformative pedagogy. We are also collaborating closely with our international partners, in contexts as diverse as Maldives (Ministry of Education), USA (Literacy Chicago, Kepler Neighbourhood School), Peru (ArcaBeta NGO), who are helping spread the message of Accelerating Learning for All around the world.

#### **DEVI Vision & Mission**

DEVI Sansthan (Dignity Education Vision International), a non-profit organization with a global reach, is spearheading educational transformation with a special focus on foundational literacy. Our revolutionary approach embeds global citizenship skills and climate change education. With the vision of universal literacy, we use research-backed, swift, scalable, and replicable techniques and methodologies to effect lasting change.

## **Why Literacy**

Literacy is the foundation of a child's education. Universal literacy is key to a nation's peace, progress and prosperity. The ability to read, write and do basic arithmetic is a key human right, without which many other rights cannot be realised.

The benefits of literacy are numerous- a Cambridge study in India found that a mere 4% increase in literacy rate would have the same positive effect on reducing child mortality as a 25% reduction in the poverty rate. Sadly over 250 million illiterate adults are in India - about 40% of the world's illiterate population. 70% of 10-year-olds in Low and Middle Income Countries around the world cannot read. We urgently need to tackle this literacy crisis.

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


# Growth Trajectory

## From 20 Schools to 35,000



## Research At Scale in India's Biggest State


ALfA implementation was conducted initially as randomised control trials, with schools randomly allocated to treatment and control groups. It is now being scaled up to district-wide implementation (for Grades 1-3).



## 2023

Shamli implementation covered in a chapter by Harvard professor Fernando Reimers; is scaled up to 210 schools. Implementation scales up in Uttar Pradesh's Lucknow, Unnao, Barabanki districts. Hilauli block of Unnao implements ALfA across all its 155 schools, later tops NAT. MOU signed with Himachal Pradesh government.

## **Rapid Results Initiative**

Dignity Education is working with government and NGO partners to pilot and scale up the Accelerating Learning for All program. Our framework, the Rapid Results Initiative (RRI) progresses through three stages—Explore, Expand, Embed.



Stage 1 Explore

Research implementation in a few schools, randomly allocated to treatment and control.



Stage 2 Expand

Scale the implementation to more schools covering one or more low-performing districts.



Stage 3 Embed

Integrate system-wide as a supplement or in the government textbooks & teacher training systems.

## Stage 1 | Explore | Research Implementation

**Objective & scope:** Conduct pilots in a few schools to establish proof of concept that FLN goals can be achieved quickly using ALfA pedagogy. We suggest 4 treatment schools + 4 control schools.

**Roles & Cost-sharing:** DEVI Sansthan is offering free online training, learning materials, and assessments. The implementation partner should arrange appropriate monitoring and third-party assessments.

**Research Design:** Pre-post difference in difference analysis (RCT design).

### **Implementation Options**

**Standard Model:** The ALfA program consists of 45 working days, with one hour dedicated to literacy and one hour to numeracy each day.

**Intensive Model:** 30 working days with full-day FLN focus using ALfA in a mission mode, without other subjects.



#### **School Selection**

Random selection and assignment of treatment and control schools.



#### Implementation-

Structured daily lessons in foundational literacy and numeracy.



#### **Baseline Assessments**

Third-party-validated tests to measure initial skill levels.



#### **Endline Assessments**

Measure progress using post-tests and real-time analytics via Pragati app.



#### **Teacher Training**

Online or in-person, covering ALfA pedagogy and classroom triggers.



#### **Model Schools**

Establish ALfA Model Schools as hubs for observation and inspiration.

## Stage 2 | Expand | Scaling the Implementation

Objective & Scope Broaden the initiative to multiple clusters or districts (hundreds of schools).

**Cost-sharing** DEVI Sansthan is offering free online training and soft copies of learning

materials and assessments. The implementation partner should arrange

bulk printing, and if venue/travel if physical training is required.

Research Design Comparison of block- or district- level data with another geography not

implementing ALfA.

#### **Activities**

1. **Cluster Expansion:** Scale pilots to include underperforming regions.

2. **Monitoring and Feedback:** Use midline and endline assessments to collect more feedback and 3rd party evidence.

3. **Capacity Building:** Train local educators and supervisors to sustain the program.

4. **Regional Demonstrations:** Showcase model schools to policymakers and other stakeholders.

## Stage 3 | Embed | Systemic Integration

**Objective & Scope** Embed ALfA pedagogy for systemic integration and long-term transformation

across a whole region or state (thousands of schools).

**Cost-sharing** DEVI Sansthan will continue offering free knowledge partnership, with the

implementation partner arranging bulk printing. The program can be roughly cost-neutral as some pages may be removed from the existing curriculum to

avoid duplicacy.

**Research Design** State- or national- level test results.

#### **Activities**

- 1. **Curriculum Integration:** Embed ALfA into national textbooks and teacher guides.
- 2. **Teacher Development:** Develop systemic training programs emphasizing paired learning, critical thinking, and inclusion.
- Sustainability Mechanisms: Build local capacity and monitoring systems to ensure self-reliance.



## Literacy


ALfA Literacy draws upon children's natural ability to derive first sounds of pictures they know, as versus first sounds of letters they do not know. Children are able to derive these first sounds and add them on their own to form words from the first day. They read by taking turns and ask each other questions.

A 40-page ALfA booklet and 45 school days are enough to swiftly build reading and early writing skills. Based on this foundation, children develop deeper understanding, richer vocabulary and greater fluency in reading and writing with time.

Each lesson introduces 4-6 letters. If the students aren't familiar with the pictures associated with each letter, then you may need to do some activities to introduce them

Prompts explain the process and also provide links to more resources.





**Creativity** expands by solving questions using hands-on materials


**Critical thinking** is built through making questions for each other.

## A Joyful Pedagogy

Accelerating Learning for All (ALfA) is not just fast and holistic, it is also a joy for students and teachers alike.

#### **PAIRED LEARNING**

The transaction of learning is not from teacher to student, but rather between two children. Students feel highly connected to each other.





#### **PEDAGOGY**

Children work from known to unknown: rather than 'a for apple', they derive the first sound from a picture. This gives a sense of achievement and satisfaction.

#### **CURRICULUM**

Books are simple, modular, and highly visual, enabling children to learn independently. They are not psychologically burdensome like many traditional textbooks.





## COLLABORATE NOT COMPETE

ALfA tests measure students' progress, rather than giving marks that foster competition against each other.

## **Inclusion For All**

ALfA is a fundamentally inclusive pedagogy. The use of random pairing ensures that everyone can take part in the class fairly, and helps build a joyful environment.


## Comparison with Other Pedagogies

"One of the challenges facing many teachers is the extreme diversity of learning levels. Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) solves this problem by grouping students by ability, whereas ALFA transforms the mixed learning levels from a challenge to a strength through paired learning.

While ALfA is newer and still emerging compared to established programs such as TaRL and Structured Pedagogy, its ability to deliver swift learning gains positions it as a promising strategy."




In a government test conducted in November 2023 (partway through the ALfA implementation), Hilauli topped the ranking among Unnao's 17 blocks. 85 of Hilauli's schools were tested, out of which 40 were deemed to be 'NIPUN schools'.\* This translates to 47% of Hilauli's schools being NIPUN, over triple the rate for Unnao overall (15%) and double the state average (24%).

A 'NIPUN school' is defined as one in which 80% or more of sampled students passed the basic literacy assessment in each of Grade 1, 2 and 3.


- \* Effect size (in this case, Cohen's d) is a statistical measure of how substantial the impact of an intervention is. This measure is not applicable (NA) in interventions without a control group.
- Equivalent Years of Schooling. A World Bank report (scan/click QR) has estimated that a typical year of schooling in LMICs generates learning gains of 0.15-0.21 effect size. An intervention with 1 EYOS means children in the treatment group gained the learning equivalent of 1 year of 'normal' schooling.



## **Nipun Assessment Test**

The NIPUN Assessment Test was conducted in schools across Uttar Pradesh in late 2023, and results were released in February 2024. District-wise analysis showed a strong correlation between the proportion of schools taking up ALfA in a particular district, and its scores on the NAT, as shown in the figure below.

## Faisal's Story: Standing on Your Own Legs

A childhood accident had left Faisal hobbling with a bent left leg bent. Despite his physical impediment, he embraced life with a bamboo pole for support, working tirelessly in a sweatshop to provide for his young family. DEVI was able to finally help Faisal get surgery in March 2023. The intricate process involved cutting the webbing, applying a skin graft, and inserting metal pins to straighten his leg.

The subsequent months required patience and perseverance as Firoz underwent physiotherapy to regain mobility. Custommade shoes and a supportive team facilitated his journey, from walker to cane and eventually walking independently.

Now Firoz is back at work. He dreams of opening his own purse-making business; and, one day, of owning his own home.

Chapter 8 of the book by Harvard Graduate School of Education (HGSE), Cambridge, USA, published in March 2023 documents the ALfA program in Shamli, and recommends its widespread adoption in UP.


Chapters 8 also documents results from the ALfA program from a Randomized Control Trial (RCT) conducted in the Shamli district of Uttar Pradesh. The RCT demonstrates a significant effect size of 0.23 for Grade 3 and 0.89 for Grade 5.

Chapter 10 of the same book is about the introduction of ALfA program at the nationwide level in the Republic of Maldives.

On this and next page are some extracts from the chapter on FLN in UP by HGSE.

We recommend the UP government (1) incorporate the promising
ALfA pedagogy developed by DEVI for the first 6 weeks to quickly establish a strong FLN foundation, (2) after the ALfA program, shift to the curriculum.

Accelerated Learning for All (ALfA), helps children quickly gain FLN competencies. The pedagogical approach works as follows: students start with known words in the form of pictures, identify the sounds, and work backward to the letters.



Students in the intervention groups had much higher ORF [oral reading fluency] levels than those in the reference group. For Grades 4-5, 50% of the intervention group students were able to read the passage at >90 words per minute (WPM) compared to 20% of reference group students.

The effect size\* of the project was **0.23 for Grade 3** students and **0.89 for Grade 5**... the results suggest there is significant value in pursuing the ALFA model in other schools if implemented in a coherent, structured, and coordinated manner.





\*Effect size is a statistical measure of how substantial the impact of an intervention is. 0.23 is considered a substantial effect size, and 0.89 very large.




The Ministry of Education engaged DEVI Sansthan (with UNICEF support) to undertake an ALfA pilot across the whole country's **200+ schools**.





In the first phase of the implementation, 13 schools are implementing ALfA while 5 are serving as a reference. From September to December 2023, test scores in ALfA schools improved 7 percentage points in English and 11 percentage points in Maths – nearly **double the rate** of improvement compared to reference group schools.
