It was with a great sense of satisfaction and joy that Devi Sansthan received the renewed MOU from the Government of Uttar Pradesh, enabling them to continue ALfA (Accelerated Learning for All) work in Barabanki, Lucknow, Shamli and Unnao and expand ALfA to 5 of UP's 8 aspirational districts: Bhabraich, Balrampur, Chitrakoot, Siddharthnagar and Sonbhadra. With this, their reach in U.P. grows from 7,500 schools last year to a commitment for 17,500 schools.
